The Clinton County 4-H Council has been hard at work planning the 2025 4-H Trips. 4-H members can earn a 2025 trip scholarship by meeting four criteria. The criteria are:

- 1.) Enrolled in 4-H in Clinton County and completed a project during the 2023-2024 4-H Year.
- 2.) Attended at least 50 percent of their club organizational/business meetings.
- 3.) Completed a helping job at the 2024 Fair.
- 4.) Submitted their year-end report in September 2024.

These trips are coordinated by the Clinton County 4-H Council for the benefit of 4-H Members. The Council pays 75% of the trip expenses for Scholarship Winners. All current 2024-2025 enrollment year 4-H members can join in on the 4-H Trips, but if you do not qualify for a scholarship from the last program year you will need to pay the full cost of the trip.

Those families who have Cloverbuds in kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, or 3rd grades know that all will be invited to participate in their trips at Scholarship cost if they are enrolled in a 4-H club for the 2024-2025 program year at the time of the trip.

Youths can choose 1 trip for their scholarship:

- K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade will only have the option of Binder Park Zoo.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade will be able to choose from the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> grade trip.
- 4<sup>th</sup> Grade – 10<sup>th</sup> grade will be able to choose from their grade plus the grade directly above and below them.
- 11<sup>th</sup> Grade will be able to choose from 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grades trips.
- 12<sup>th</sup> Grade/Post High School will be able to choose from 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade trips.

You can attend more than one trip but will need to pay the full price of the second trip instead of the scholarship price. Trip registration can be done online at <https://bit.ly/2025TripRegistration>. When submitting your registration online you will be invoiced by the 4-H Council Financial Secretary for your trip via email.

Volunteers are needed to Chaperone all trips. The number of Chaperones needed per trip is dependent on the number of youths registered for the trip. If you would like to volunteer as a Chaperone/Driver, you must be an Active Gold Volunteer for MSU Clinton County Extension. To become an Active Gold Volunteer you can submit an application at [https://msu.samaritan.com/custom/502/volunteer\\_login](https://msu.samaritan.com/custom/502/volunteer_login). AN APPLICATION TO BE A CHAPERONE FOR A TRIP WILL ALSO NEED TO BE COMPLETED AT <https://bit.ly/2025ChaperoneRegistration>. Once registrations have closed you will be contacted to let you know if you have been accepted or not as a Chaperone.
