IMPORTANT INFORMATION!!

This is a high honor award for the county. To apply for achievement, citizenship or leadership awards please use the following guidelines:

- 1. <u>Achievement:</u> Emphasizes leadership, citizenship, knowledge and application of skills learned in 4-H and how you have helped others and/or your club.
 - <u>Citizenship:</u> Emphasizes 4-H activities in community service, the ability to work and get along with others and being a good citizen.
 - <u>Leadership</u>: Emphasizes active 4-H leadership experience and willingness to accept new leadership responsibilities.
- 2. Nominations to apply for an award must come from a 4-H leader. A leader signature agreeing to the information in the application is required.
- 3. Members must have 2 years of 4-H experience for this award and be enrolled in 4-H during the program year of the award.
- 4. If you were nominated in more than three award areas, including county medals and other awards, you must choose which three areas you want to apply for. (You are limited to submitting three applications, including the areas of leadership, achievement or citizenship and all county award metals.)
- 5. This form must be submitted directly to the Eaton County MSU Extension office or emailed to gottjess@msu.edu by October 31st.
- 6. The county awards committee will select the winners to be announced at the 4-H Council Participation Celebration.
- 7. (Optional) Leader may submit a short, signed paragraph recommending the member for the award.
