- D. Completed a teen leadership project.
- E. Participated in three State sponsored or State 4-H events.
- F. Been recommended by local leader.
- G. Past winners are not eligible.

Members must return their completed application along with this signed form to the Extension Office or emailed to gottjess@msu.edu by December 20th. The awards will be made at the Participation Recognition Celebration.
