

Project Results


Four Pillars of Action

- Each pillar included communitydefined leverage points to help launch action






Pillar 1:

Response" Loop






Pillar 2: Economic Investment





Pillar 3: Community Collaborative Action






Pillar 4: Resident Food Empowerment
