PEN SET UP

- Sunday, July 14, 11am. This is where beef exhibitors and families come in to set the pens up for fair week. We will put up rails and sweep the barn at the time.
- Decorations can go up after the barn has been sanitized.

CHECK-IN: Saturday, August 4, from 5-8pm

- You must wait in line and not unload any animal until it is your turn.
- YQCA certificate is due at check-in MANDATORY!

SHOWMANSHIP: Monday, August 6 @1:00 PM - MANDATORY! BREEDING & MARKET: To Follow

BARN RULES:

- Walkways must be kept free of clutter.
- Stalls and club areas must be cleaned by 9:00 AM daily.
- Clean up manure throughout the day, each day.
- Tack and feed need to be kept in your assigned space NO TACK or personal items in the walkways.
- Both neck ropes and halters are required to be on your 4-H beef and dairy steers, heifers, and feeder calves.

SHOW ATTIRE:

- NO FLIP FLOPS OR OPEN TOED SHOES of any kind!
- Nice long sleeve shirt long enough to tuck in and clean jeans (i.e., no holes or rips)
- NO LOW TOPS!

AUCTION: Thursday, August 9

- Luncheon & Registration starts at 12:00 PM. Auction begins at 2:00 PM
- Auction order: Sheep, Swine, Beef
- Every participant should help set up the arena and help serve the auction dinner.
- You need to be ready with your animal and in line when your name is called.
- You will get thank you cards after your project goes through the auction arena Thursday night and they are due back 10am noon under the Small Animal tent on Friday.

OTHER:

- For loadout Saturday, August 11, you will need to be at your stall by 11:00 PM so you are ready to load when your name is called.
- NO FLIP FLOPS when around your animal!
