

Deer & Rabbit Repellent

1 egg
1/2 cup milk
1 Tablespoon cooking oil
1 Tablespoon liquid dish detergent
1 gallon water

Beat egg; mix with milk, cooking oil and detergent. Add to water. Shake well.

Apply to landscape plants every two weeks, after every rain, or as needed.

Homemade Deer Repellent

Ingredients:

1 gallon of water
1 tablespoons of cooking oil
2 to 6 drops of hot sauce

Stir to mix.



Add:

2 tablespoons liquid dish soap

Slowly stir this mixture together.

For a *vole or mole* problem:

Add 2 tablespoons castor oil

Add mixture to a spray bottle that puts out a fine mist to cover plants. Must be repeated after a rain (at least until the deer get the message that this is an awful tasting plant).

Personal note from Arlene: I don't know why the castor oil couldn't be used instead of the vegetable or olive oil in the first place?
